

Windows 2000 DHCP setup

To configure your high speed connection on Windows 2000 please follow these steps.

1. 1. Click on **Start**, point to **Settings** and click on **Control Panel**.
2. 2. Double click on the **Network and Dial-up Connections** icon.
3. 3. Right click on the icon named **Local Area Connection** and from the menu that appears, select **Properties**.
4. 4. Double Click on **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)**, and place a dot beside BOTH **Obtain an IP address automatically . . .** and . . . **Obtain DNS server address automatically**.
5. 5. Click on **OK** and then **OK** again on the next screen to save your changes
