

Will the SW Stream App Work on My Smart TV? v2.1

The SW Stream app works on many Smart TVs that use **Roku TV** or **Fire TV** operating systems. If your TV already runs Roku TV OS or Fire TV OS, you can install and stream without any additional devices.

If you own a **Samsung, LG, or Vizio** Smart TV, you will need a supported streaming device such as a **Roku Ultra, Roku LT, Fire TV 4K Stick, or Fire TV Cube** to use the SW Stream app.

Smart TVs With Roku TV OS (SW Stream App Works Without Extra Device)

These models have Roku built in and do not require a separate streaming player.
